“Muddy Waters and the Minnesota River Blues”

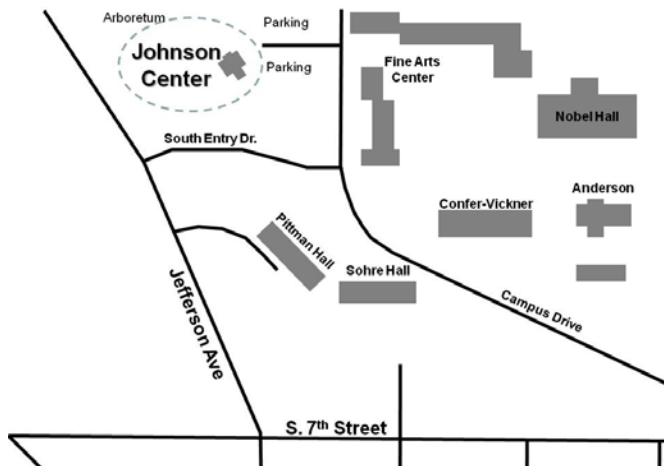
Learn how the history of glaciation, river evolution, climate change and land-use practices have had unintentional impacts on the Minnesota River and its tributaries.

Dr. Jennings is a glacial geologist at the Minnesota Geological Survey, University of Minnesota, with background in glaciology and geomorphology and an interest in process. She is interested in how glaciers respond to a variety of forces, how that affects the sediment record in Minnesota, and how this helps us predict the behavior of modern ice sheets.
