

Wednesday, April 16, 2008 – Lake Pepin TMDL Policy Forum

The Lake Pepin TMDL is nearing completion. It will set pollutant load allocations needed to clean up the Mississippi River through Lake Pepin. The Second Lake Pepin TMDL Policy Forum will invite local stakeholders to learn from river scientists the magnitude of pollutant load reductions that will be needed to restore the Mississippi River, and to demonstrate with local examples how sediment and phosphorus discharges and runoff can be substantially reduced. Results from the forum and subsequent discussions will be shared with the Lake Pepin TMDL Stakeholder Advisory committee.
